CONDITIONS OF DEDICATION

- 1. All requests for new memorial bench seats with plaques or for plaques to be fixed on existing bench seats must be made on full completion of an Application Form signed and submitted to the Town Clerk.
- 2. New memorial bench seats must be of a type, design and colour approved by Bewdley Town Council (BTC). The Town Clerk (or Assistant Clerk) will discuss your requirements with you.
- 3. BTC will try and accommodate the applicant's first preference for the bench and/or plaque location. However, it reserves the right to refuse an application if the preferred location is unsuitable and to offer an alternative site. Sites are limited to either land which forms part of the public highway or land within parks, amenity areas and public open spaces (subject to County/District Council approval).
- 4. Once the location (with necessary consents) and type of bench and plaque inscription have been agreed with the donor, the Council will issue and invoice for the appropriate amount (see charge below). Payment in full by way of cheque will be required as a condition of the order then being progressed. Cheques must be made payable to 'Bewdley Town Council'.
- 5. On payment of the agreed fee, BTC undertakes to obtain, fit, insure and maintain the memorial bench and/or plaques for a fixed term of 10 years. After this time, BTC will consider continued maintenance and the subsequent arrangement may be subject to a further fee being charged, as appropriate at that time. If the donor cannot be contacted for any reason, BTC will use its discretion to decide appropriate action. If the donor chooses not to pay a further fee, the Council will return the plaque to the donor, if requested to do so.
- 6. Once the seat and/or plaque is/are installed it becomes the property of BTC and will be recorded in the Asset Register. No maintenance of any kind should be undertaken by the donor, their family or their representatives.
- 7. The brass plaque will be of a maximum size of 150mm x 60mm. The maximum number of words is 15. The plaque will be fixed to the upper back rail or slat of the bench facing forwards. No bench seat will have more than one plaque. The precise wording of the any plaque or inscription must be approved by the Town Clerk with the object of having some consistently in the nature of the wording and style of lettering.
- 8. This policy does not apply to bench seats being placed on privately owned land over which the Council has no control.
